The majority of open programs occur from 4:00pm - 5:00pm and in the evenings. Most open programming does not require prior sign-up. A Scout can simply show-up at a program area when they would like to participate in an open program. Expanded open program opportunities in the evenings are also offered in addition to afternoons. | | | | | |
| Age Restrictions: | Some programs have required age minimums and some programs have recommended age minimums. The purpose of age restrictions varies from program to p When listed as "Recommended Age 13+", if the Scout is under the recommended age, it is suggested that the Scout have a conversation with their Scoutmass Summer Camp Coordinator prior to signing-up for that merit badge. | | | | | |
| Partial Week Programs: | All programs meet Monday through Friday unless indicated otherwise next to the Merit Badge/Activity name. For example, Rowing meets on Monday, Tuesday Wednesday. There are numerous opportunities in the program schedule to match-up two partial week activities so that a Scout has a full week of activities duri particular hour. | | | | | |
